


Español AP

This course is equivalent to a third year college course in Advanced Spanish language skills. We speak exclusively Spanish and use authentic materials from many countries. A significant portion of the course prepares students to speak and write on academic topics. Among the topics we will examine include: how changes in technology may help or hurt people, a debate on climate change and other environmental issues, the do's and don'ts of dating in other countries, the roots of our own identity, traditional and contemporary gender roles, architecture and what it tells us about a place, the struggle of migrant farmworkers in the US, celebrations throughout the Spanish-speaking world, indigenous approaches to health care, endangered species, regional dialects and many more topics. The full syllabus submitted to the College Board is fifteen pages long; if you are curious you can download the whole thing from our edmodo class page!


You must speak only Spanish in class

Going to miss class?


